Welcome to BPC_Guest WIFI network ('BPC_Guest'). Before connecting to the BPC_Guest WIFI, please read these terms and conditions carefully (the 'Terms'). These Terms make up the terms and conditions for use of the BPC_Guest WIFI. We may make changes to these Terms from time to time, so we recommend that you review these regularly. The terms 'we', 'our' and 'us' when used in these Terms mean BPC. The terms 'you', 'your', 'yours', when used in these Terms mean you as a user of the BPC_Guest WIFI as the context requires. By clicking the "Connect to the Internet" button you confirm that you accept these Terms, you acknowledge that you have read and understood and agree to all the Terms.

1. Using the BPC_Guest WIFI

The BPC_Guest WIFI is a free service. You can continue to use the BPC_Guest WIFI free of charge when in Blacksmiths Barn as long as you continue to accept our Terms.

You can connect to BPC_Guest WIFI using a compatible phone or computer device with wireless LAN. We do not guarantee that the BPC_Guest WIFI is compatible with all hardware types and devices or guarantee device connectivity.

To connect to the BPC_Guest WIFI you will not need to provide any personal information; however details from the device you are using to connect to our network will be recorded.

The BPC_Guest WIFI is intended for browsing the internet and using apps.

We are not responsible for the content of websites you visit while using the BPC_Guest WIFI. We may at our sole discretion restrict access to certain features and websites.

2. Children and Young Adult Users

Children and young adults under the age of 18 are not permitted to use the BPC_Guest WIFI.

3. Reliability

We do not guarantee uninterrupted access to the BPC_Guest WIFI and we may suspend the service at any time, for any reason, at our sole discretion. The BPC_Guest WIFI is not a secure network and we are not responsible for the security of the information and data which you transmit using the BPC_Guest WIFI. We are not responsible for the accuracy of any information or data obtained from the internet using the BPC_Guest WIFI.

4. How we use your information

By using the BPC_Guest WIFI you agree that your device details will be stored.

We reserve the right to report on any activity undertaken on the BPC_Guest WIFI and where necessary restrict or block access to a person, account, website or device.

5. Our liability to you

Nothing in these Terms shall restrict or exclude our liability for death or personal injury arising from our negligence nor any other liability which cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law. We shall not be liable to you in contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty or otherwise arising for:

- loss of income or revenue;
- loss of business;
- loss of profits or contracts;
- loss of anticipated savings;
- loss of opportunity or goodwill;
- loss of, damage to, or corruption, of data; or
- indirect or consequential loss of any kind

6. What you must not do on the BPC_Guest WIFI

You agree not to:
